**PROJECT:** Overall maintenance responsibility for Mobil's Main Pass Properties

Term of Contract – Five (5) Years

Total Horsepower – 26,500

**PROJECT SUMMARY:**

Preventive Maintenance Services took over responsibility for the Main Pass equipment in October of 1998. The contract is all-inclusive. This means that PMSI has total responsibility for the mechanical availability and performance of all equipment on the Main Pass Mobil platforms including the power and compression. PMSI furnishes all parts, labor, fluids, technical expertise, and all ancillary services related to the performance of reciprocating equipment. Below is a list of equipment PMSI is responsible for:

- 1 – IR KVSR12
- 1 – IR KVS
- 1 – IR KVSF12
- 1 – Waukesha 12V-AT25GL
- Several Waukesha 9390 Engines (Driving IR HOS Compressors)
- Several Waukesha 7042 Units (Driving IR HOS Compressors)
- Small Waukesha units including 3711's, and 2475's

As part of the program we manage generator units, salt-water pumps, fire water pumps, and small electric motors. In essence PMSI owns the equipment for purposes of maintenance and mechanical performance.

This is a performance-based contract, which makes the program work well for PMSI and Baker/Mobil. PMSI must meet a minimum mechanical availability to meet their contract obligations.
