PROJECT SUMMARY:

Preventive Maintenance Services contracted with TransCanada in 1998 to re-grout four (4) Cooper-Bessemer GMX units in Eunice, LA. There were two four-cylinder units, one six-cylinder unit, and one eight-cylinder unit. Our scope of work was to re-grout each unit and then re-align engine and compressors. We also contracted to perform any mechanical work we found necessary. This included replacement of main bearings, heads, compressor parts, and replacement of gaskets, and seals to stop severe oil leaks. The leaks for the most part were a result of overdue maintenance and overhauls.

This project lasted for four months and required a good deal of additional work beyond the original scope. No additional work was performed without the written approval of TransCanada management.
